Keuring Info: Keurings typically start early in the mornings with BWP/NAD Reps pulling DNA on the mares & foals and completing markings - this is conducted in the stalls with the owners handling their horses. Once markings are completed we move on to presentations.

Presentations: We request mares to be braided and shown in a bridle. Foals will have their halters removed after their conformation is inspected. Yearlings can be shown in a halter & 2YO's in a bridle. Mares are shown in hand with foals by their side and foals at liberty. Braiding of foals is optional but encouraged. Presenters are encouraged to wear white shirts/khaki pants and comfortable running shoes. Please check with your keuring hosts for availability of handlers, braiders & photographers.
