BIO AND PERFORMANCE RECORD:

Capone I was approved for breeding in Germany. He is by the international superstar jumper sire Contender. While Contender hardly needs introduction, it is worth remembering how he became so famous, namely his reputation for production of both outstanding sportshorses and breeding mares, as well as most notably his production of stunning stallion sons the world around. Contender's approved sons in the Holsteiner registry alone number well into the double-digits, and he is used by nearly every warmblood breed in Europe as an important improvement sire.

Not only himself a successful competition horse and also impeccably-bred Holsteiner stallion, Capone I impresses many with his good nature and charming ways. Equally at home on a trail ride with friends as he is in the victory gallop at Spruce, Capone I breaks many North American misconceptions about stallions. With his breeding duties neatly interwoven into his training and competition schedule, Capone demonstrates the sound mind and gentle soul that is prized by so many who breed horses to be champions and willing companions.

Capone has produced several successful foal crops, with more mare owners every year choosing him for their breeding stock. So far, we see Capone foals with a strong "stamp" from their handsome father. Compact, athletic, elegant, and well-balanced, his foals also stand out strongly with their super temperaments through friendly minds, generous hearts, and a kind eye that is immediately recognized as "a Capone" the world around.

Capone has an outstanding competition record that spans many Grand Prix wins and International ring appearances from Florida, California, Langley B.C., and Spruce Meadows respectively.

2011 season saw Kyle King ride Capone to the CN Performance victory at Spruce Meadows against a field of the worlds best. Another impressive achievement for Capone's career. Capone was also awarded the prestigious "Elite Stallion" award by the BWP in 2012.
