Transportation for Judges & BWP Personnel

Site Hosts must provide transportation to/from the airport, hotel and keuring site. Hosts will be given the flight information for arrival and departure.

The BWP/NAD attempts to serve as many sites across the U.S. each year. In order to cover travel expenses, we will need a guarantee of a minimum number of horses or \$1,500 in entries for each site in the U.S. and \$2,000 outside the U.S. (Canada/Mexico)

Hosts that have additional fees for their site must be approved by the BWP/NAD prior to the keuring. Site fees that are not pre-approved may not be charged to participants.
